Create an Emergency Kit:

Buy your emergency kit items early in the hurricane season. Make sure your kit includes

- Non-perishable food and water (at least a 3-day supply)
- Medications and medical supplies
- Battery-powered or hand-crank radio
- Flashlights and extra batteries
- First aid kit
- Personal hygiene items
- Important documents (insurance policies, identification)
- Cash and credit cards
- Extra clothing and blankets
- Tools and supplies for securing your home
